Walking the Bible: A Journey by Land through the Five

Books of Moses (Book/DVD, 3 Sessions) Feiler, Bruce S. One part adventure story, one part archaeological detective work, one part spiritual exploration, "Walking the Bible" vividly recounts an inspiring personal odyssey--by foot, jeep, rowboat, and camel--through the greatest stories ever told. Feiler explores how geography affects the larger narrative of the Bible and how much these places have affected his own faith. (*Perennial, 2005*)



The Great Adventure: A Journey Through the Bible

(DVD, 8 sessions) The Catholic Church gave us the Bible. It is the story of our family, told by the loving God who created us. We hear the Bible read at Mass, but often we wonder how those readings fit together. The Great Adventure helps you make the connection. It is a Catholic Bible study because it shows how the story that runs through Scripture is the story that grounds the Catholic faith. The Great Adventure helps you live your life in that story today. (*Ascension Press, 2004*)

Women in the New Testament (Book/DVD, 7 sessions) Little Rock Scripture Study. Provides a cultural and religious context for the New Testament by outlining the position of women in the Greco-Roman world; and examines representative New Testament passages in an effort to show how early Christianity attempted to liberate people from oppression. (*Liturgical Press, 2001*)

Footprints of God Series (DVD, 8 sessions) A documentary film series hosted by popular Catholic author, speaker, and apologist Steve Ray, who takes you on amazing journeys of discovery and adventure to meet the people and see the places of Scripture and Church history. Journey through the lands of the Bible to meet the key figures in salvation history. It is the most original and dynamic DVD series in Catholic Church history! The Footprints Of God: The Story Of Salvation From Abraham To Augustine will take you on a journey of discovery through the sweeping saga of salvation. (*Ignatius Press, 2001-2014*)

Priest, Prophet, King (DVD, 6 sessions) The better we understand Jesus, the better we understand ourselves. But who was Jesus, this itinerant preacher whom many called the Messiah? In Priest, Prophet, King, you'll discover Jesus as the Anointed One—the ultimate priest, prophet, and king foreshadowed throughout the Hebrew Scriptures. Using biblical insights and engaging stories, Bishop Barron affirms that we see Jesus most clearly through the lens of the Old Testament. This deeply biblical program, filmed in high-definition video, features an accompanying study guide by notable Catholic writer and apologist, Carl Olson, written under Bishop Barron's direction. T3: The Teen Timeline (DVD, 8 sessions) The Teen Timeline—or T3—is the teen version of the revolutionary Great Adventure Bible Timeline learning system that hundreds of thousands of Catholic adults have used to learn the Bible. Dynamic teen presenter Mark Hart makes the Bible come alive for Catholic teens by unpacking God's Word in a way they can relate to. T3 teaches teens the Bible by showing them the "big picture" of salvation history. When young students of the Bible first understand the "story," they are eager to learn more. The net result: teens begin to wrap their minds and hearts around the Scriptures. They come to see the Bible as a relevant part of their lives. (*Ascension Press, 2010*)

Encounter: Experiencing God in Everyday (DVD, 8 sessions) Encounter: Experiencing God in the Everyday is an eight-part bible study for middle school kids. In this DVD series Mark Hart provides a compelling overview and explanation of the entire biblical story. Designed specifically for 6th to 8th grades, Encounter uses the color-coded Bible Timeline learning system to reveal the story of our faith and God's plan for our lives. As your students are drawn into this story they will come to a new and profound understanding of who God is. Most importantly they will see God not as a distant doctrinal concept, but as a loving Father who desires a meaningful and lasting encounter with them. (*Ascension Press, 2013*)

Exodus: Called to Freedom (DVD, 10 sessions) The Exodus can be viewed as the defining moment in Israel's history, for it was then that God called Israel out of slavery in Egypt and to a life of freedom as His people. Exodus: Called to Freedom looks through the lens of Christ and the Church to show that, more than just seeking to free His people from the domination of Pharaoh, God desired to free His people from the far more sinister tyranny of sin, so they could live the authentic freedom that belongs to children of God. Because of this, the Exodus story is not just Israel's story, it is our story as well; it tells us who God is and what He calls us to be. (*Ascension Press, 2010*)
